Regular City Commissioner Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton. Mayor Shelton led the invocation.

Roll call was performed by City Clerk, all were present for meeting,

Last month's meetings minutes were reviewed and no changes needed to be made, Commissioner Keith Saylor, made the motion to accept last month's minutes as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Chris Sandlin, all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Juanita Pettit, made the motion to accept as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Chris Sandlin, all in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Reports

City Commissioner Jerry Shelton stated the East End Ambulance service is now Lincoln Co Emergency Med Service. The monies were dispersed last month for the Ambulance Board and this was from last year's tax dollars. Crab Orchard received approximately 80k.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner, Keith Saylor has nothing to report.

Water Superintendent, Devon Shelton reported we had several frozen water meters he has replaced or repaired. The water loss was 40% for this month.

Emergency Services Commissioner, Chris Sandlin wanted to thank Police Chief Jimmy Gipson for his efforts and he had 8 more arrest this month than last.

Police Chief Jimmy Gipson reported details for his monthly activity, (see attached).

Streets and Roads Commissioner, Juanita Pettit stated she has spoken with Luther Galloway with AGE in regards to the sidewalk project and he stated they are continuing to work the state engineers in regards to a possible drainage issues. He still believes we can bid it out this spring.

The salt spreader auger is not working and will need to be repaired. There also has been reported by a resident on Garden Lane that a dead tree is near the electric lines, will contact Kentucky Utilities to see the limb can wait until spring when they will perform all tree trimming or see if this one is a potential hazard and needs immediate attention. Reported a street light out on 717 Meadowlark Drive.

The issue of the back pay for the Police Chief and the effect it was to have on the Police Dept budget by City Commissioner, Jerry Shelton. Since the 5900.00 would completely deplete the Police Dept Account, Water/Wastewater Commissioner moved to make motion that the 3 large departments, city, sewer and water split the \$5900.00 three ways at \$1900.00 each to be deposited. Commissioner Chris Sandlin 2nd the motion, the vote was 3 yeas, Commissioners, Keith Saylor, Juanita Pettit and Chris Sandlin to 1 nae, Commissioner Jerry Shelton, motion carried.

Police Chief Jimmy Gipson brought to the Commissions attention the request for funding from the Lincoln Co Sheriff's Office for donations for a new K9 drug dog. Commissioner Juanita Pettit made the motion to donate \$500.00 and the funds to be taken from the Streets and Road, Commissioner Chris Sandlin 2nd the motion, the vote was 3 yeas, Commissioners, Keith Saylor, Juanita Pettit and Chris Sandlin to 1 nae, Commissioner Jerry Shelton, motion carried.

Police Chief stated every effort has been made to locate the owner of 520 Cedar Street, the house that had been recently damaged by a drunk driver. The house will need to be boarded up and we have someone that will work for \$10.00 per hour and will board the house and try to make the porch area as safe and secure to the public. City Commissioner agreed to do so and then if the rightful owners are located they can reimburse the city back the monies spent or a lien can be placed on the home.

Again it was asked when the Christmas Lights will be taken down, we had two people state they would take them down at \$10.00 per hour and City Commissioner, Jerry Shelton stated he did not want to pay anyone to remove them.

Nothing more to discuss.

Commissioner Juanita Pettit made the motion to adjourn, 2nd by Commissioner Chris Sandlin, all in favor, motion carried, and meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
