The meeting was called to order at 6:35 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton, Mayor Shelton led the invocation.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; all were present for meeting, Commissioner Jerry Shelton arrived at 6:35 pm.

Last month's meetings minutes were reviewed and no changes needed to be made, Commissioner Chris Sandlin, made the motion to accept last month's minutes as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Keith Saylor, all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Juanita Pettit, made the motion to accept as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Chris Sandlin, all in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Reports

City Commissioner Jerry Shelton encouraged the people of Crab Orchard to attend the Ambulance Board meetings on the 3rd Monday of each month. The disbursement of the funds is to be divided but until the board received any financial reports he feels these monies should not be allocated.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Keith Saylor stated our water loss was 13% which is a significant decrease over the past few months. We purchased 3.6 million gallons and sold 2.3 million gallons total unaccounted for 486,370. Commissioner Saylor reported the Water Superintendent's monthly report, (see attached).

Streets and Road Commissioner, Juanita Pettit reported have 11 streetlights out that have been reported to Kentucky Utilities. She will contact Dustin Harmon Paving for a quote for repairs for to streets. She stated she has spoke with Luther Galloway and the sidewalk projects status is the state has completed their part so it should now be back in the counties hands to begin bid process.

Emergency Services Commissioner, Chris Sandlin gave details of Police Chiefs Jimmy Gipson monthly report (see attached).


Fire Chief Larry Owsley reported we have one truck done Engine 12 had to be towed to Danville for repairs to be made to the fuel lines.

New Business

The Mayor met with Luther Galloway and he feels the theater has a good foundation and will need quite a bit work. He Commissioners stated not to dismiss until further research can be made. Need to research any potential funding to see if grants are available.


Open Discussion
