The meeting was called to order at 6:31 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton; Mayor Shelton led the invocation and led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; all were present for meeting with the exception of Commissioner Bill Dyehouse was absent, Mayor Shelton established there was a quorum.

Streets and Road Commissioner Mike Eldridge reported looking into purchasing a city truck to be used for salt truck. Still have not heard anything from Dustin Harmon regarding the repairs needed to the streets.

Two interested parties attended the pre-bid meeting of the purchasing of the water and wastewater system. The information was again reiterated that the bids are due on Nov 14th at 3:00 pm and will be opened on Nov 21st at the regular work session. No questions or concerns regarding the bid.


