6:30 pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:32 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton; Mayor Shelton led the invocation and led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; all were present for meeting, Mayor Shelton established there was a quorum.

Last month's meetings minutes were reviewed and no changes needed to be made, Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to accept last month's minutes as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Kenneth Manuel, all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Keith Saylor, made the motion to accept as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Mike Eldridge, all in favor, motion carried.

Attorney John Hackley presented his bill for the work he has performed and wanted to discuss any issues the legislative body may have had. He also pointed out the Mary Murphy lot located on 401 Cherry Street has been finalized and the deed has been recorded and the old taxes will need to be paid.

The need to continue to have an Audit Account was presented and the City Clerk stated currently no funds were being transferred and any invoices received from the auditor is divided among the respective departments. Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to close the audit account, 2nd by Keith Saylor all in favor motion carried.

Commissioner Reports

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel reported Police Chiefs, Jimmy Gipson's report (see attached). 4 complaints, 3 investigations, 0 arrest made, 2 traffic citations, 12 traffic stops, and 2 domestic.

Police Chief also reported on the status of the nuisance order on the Chickens running loose on Maple Ave. The owner will be allowed to keep the chickens as long as they are maintained in a pen.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Keith Saylor reported the water loss is 17%, also reported Water Superintendents report (see attached). Also stated have communicated with Endersol they are repairing the Sewer Lift Station pumps, also need to speak with Rick Cole to check the status of violations.

Streets and Road Commissioner Mike Eldridge reported he has spoke with Shane Morgan with Allen Company to obtain a quote to repair both sides of the street on Stanford Street, will meet with another blacktop company to get an additional quote. Have not heard anything back from him. Sent a picture to Adam Smith with Kentucky Utilities to add 2 street lights one on Meadowlark and the other across from the bank.

City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse wanted to know since the release of City Maintenance Worker if we were doing well stated Darrell Brummett is keeping everything mowed. Also we will need a truck for as a snow plow, will check with the county to see if they have anything we could possibly purchase.


Open Discussion



Report for Monthly Meeting

September 5 2019

Leaks and Repairs

Repair water meter at 340 Stanford St. Installed a new box, lid, double meter, valve and setter. Took old service out had a small leak on service line going to meter.

Removed suction hose from bypass pump. Suction end became heavily clogged with rags and debris from sewer line.

Repair $\frac{3}{4}$ in. service line on Rigsby Rd. The line going to Barry Spurlin's meter had a hole in it under the road. Cut trench in road and replaced line and put gravel back in road.

Used bypass pump to back flush thru new check valves to stir up solids settling out in lift station.

Had locks put on all lift stations for security. Checked all stations for blockages and rags. Put degreaser in all stations.

Continuing to have problems with Harris lift station across from school. Both pumps were pulled last month. Pump 1 has a bad overload switch and pump 2 has a small hole in the discharge mount of pump. Pump 1 is back in service while waiting for parts for pump 2.

Removed sewer line clog between S. Elm St. and Sycamore St. Found clog while doing manhole inspections. Lots of rags, rocks and debris was built up in line.

Changed out 2 stuck meters.
