The meeting was called to order at 6:35 by Mayor Pro Tem Bill Shelton, Mayor Pro Tem Bill Shelton, led the invocation and led the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; all were present except Mayor Shelton was absent. Mayor Pro Tem Bill Dyehouse established there was a quorum.

November 2020 meetings minutes were reviewed and no changes needed to be made, Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept last month's minutes as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Keith Saylor, all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Keith Saylor made the motion to accept as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Mike Eldridge, all in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Reports:

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel reported Police Chiefs, Jimmy Gipson's report (see attached). 4 complaints, 2 investigations, 3 arrest made, 2 domestics and 10 traffic stops.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Keith Saylor discussed that the bill from Lancaster Water was significantly higher this month at 14k dollars, but it is due to the meter change out. Lancaster Water has assured us it will be lower next month. We will wait and see what the bill is before we speak with them.

Streets and Road Commissioner Mike Eldridge reported we have received two bids on the sidewalk project. One from K and T Contracting it was in the amount of \$38,750 and the other was from Charles Isaacs and his bid was \$37,000.00. After review and discussion, K and T stated he would drop his bid to \$37,000. Commissioner Mike Eldridge made the motion to accept K and T's bid, 2nd by Commissioner Kenneth Manuel, all in favor, motion carried.

Fire Chief Larry Owsley had nothing to report.

City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse, reported he has not been able to reach Ann Giles with CO Primary Care regarding the Mary Murphy Lot that she wanted to purchase.

City Attorney, John Hackley started he has spoken with Ky American Water Attorney, Lindsey Graham regarding the purchase agreement and the hydrants. He stated Ky American Water could not forgo the hydrant fee and therefore maybe there could be another alternative to the city to recoup the fee.

Discussion procuring an engineering firm for the Storm water project, after discussion, Commissioner Mike Eldridge mad the motion to accept the RFQ from Bell Engineering, 2nd by Keith Saylor all in favor. Motion carried.

Remaining CARES funding will be used to reimburse for Sewer rental of blue pump.


No new business to discuss.
