**Commissioner Reports:**



The sidewalk project is at a standstill due to the inclement weather. According to the state transportation department an encroachment permit should have been issued.


Water/Wastewater Commissioner Rick Spoonamore stated we have repaired 2 water leaks and there seems to be a leak at the bottom of Toll Gate Hill somewhere and they will test the water and see if can locate.

City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse stated they were still having issues with cloudy water on his side of town. The house at the corner of Elm and Maple has several junk cars in the yard, they will need to be addressed and moved.
