#### **Meeting Minutes**

Regular City Commissioner Meeting Minutes Crab Orchard City Hall May 6, 2021 6:30 pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:31 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton, Mayor Shelton, led the invocation and led the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; Commissioner Bill Dyehouse was absent. Mayor Shelton established there was a quorum.

April 2021 meetings minutes were reviewed and no changes needed to be made, Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept last month's minutes as stand, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Jerry Shelton, all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept as stand, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore, all in favor, motion carried.

## **Commissioner Reports:**

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel reported Police Chiefs, Jimmy Gipson's monthly report (see attached). Warning tickets 0, Complaints 6, Investigations 3, Citations 4, Domestics 0, Accidents 0, Traffic Stops 9, Case Reports 2, Arrest Made 3, Misdemeanors 1 and 2 Felony. There also has been several thefts lately in the area, Marshall Scotts side by side was stolen as well as Denola Sims riding lawn mower.

Streets and Road Commissioner Jerry Shelton stated the ambulance Board ended up last year with an overage of approximately 80K and voted to present Hustonville part of these funding's to finish their building. The LCEMS board will be the care takers of these funds and will disperse as they see fit.

There is a big pot hole in front of West Maple that needs to be addressed, Greenbriar needs the ditch line area cleaned out around the Christian Church Parsonage.

Received a \$3500.00 bid from K and T Concrete to make the driveways handicapped accessible. Everyone thought that was a good price, Commissioner Jerry Shelton made the motion to accept the bid of \$3500.00 and have K and T Concrete pour the drive ways down Elm St, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rick Spoonamoore, all in favor motion carried. Still waiting on the county to bring the rock in order to start the ditch clean up area on Walnut Street.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Rick Spoonamore reported the owner of Past Time Café would like a speed bump installed by her restaurant on Hickory Street. After much discussion the legislative body feels like there is not enough room for it to be installed and be beneficial to her. The placement of the speed bump would have to be as soon as the vehicles makes the turn and this could possibly be a detriment to people's vehicles. We will see if we can put a Slow down Children at Play sign up to maybe deter people from speeding.

May 6, 2021

New business:

Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to purchase new security cameras for the town, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore all in favor motioned carried.

Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to hire Will Davison full time and start him at \$12.50 per hour, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore all in favor motion carried.

Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to sign the inter-local agreement with Stanford to allow the use of their code enforcement officer, Jeff Knouse as we can start with HB 422 ordinance, there was not a 2<sup>nd</sup> on the floor so Commissioner Kenneth Manuel withdrew his motion.

Budget prep was passed out to the commissioners and they are to discuss any changes or issues at next work session meeting.

Delta Gas has received permit to go ahead with the gas line from Stanford trough Crab Orchard to Mount Vernon.

Willie Ashley has expressed again he would like a sidewalk in front of his shop and road in caving in.

No further business. Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to adjourn the meeting, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore, all in favor motion carried, meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
