Regular City Commissioner Meeting Minutes June 2, 2022 6:30 pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 by Mayor Pro-Tem Bill Dyehouse, Mayor Shelton led the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; All was present, Mayor Shelton established there was a quorum.

May 5, 2022, meetings minutes were reviewed no changes were needed, Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept the minutes as stand, 2nd by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), No changes need to be made, and Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept the financials, 2nd by Commissioner Jerry Shelton, all in favor motion carried.

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel reported Chiefs, Jimmy Gipson's monthly activity report (see attached). Have more than 950 square feet of occupied space in a <u>single</u>, double, or larger multi-section unit; and for <u>single wide unit</u> the lot must be an existing lot", 2nd by Commissioner Bill Dyehouse, 3 votes to one.
