### Meeting Minutes Regular City Commissioner Meeting Minutes November 3, 2022 6:30 pm

#### **Commissioner Reports**

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel had nothing to report, Chief Gipson was in training all week, he did not provide with a monthly report at this time.

Streets and Roads Commissioner, Jerry Shelton reported the black top company are to return next week to complete the Viola Street and make more repairs. We will need to dig the tap on for the water and sewer for the new house on Viola before the street is finished. The water tower project should be completed tomorrow. It will take 7 days to let dry before we can fill back up and the water will have to be tested. The float hasn't worked properly in years and that will need to be repaired in the spring if we make the other necessary repairs.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Risk Spoonamore reported we have repaired 3 leaks, Greenbriar, Burgin and Lancaster Street. The Perkins curve repair will need a boring company and we are having an issue locating one.

City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse reported he wasn't having any luck with finding a truck to purchase. The used ones are so expensive. Hensley has 2011 Chevy 2 wheel drive lots of miles for 7k dollars. We will check with David Hammonds and maybe check into a lease program.
