# **Meeting Minutes**

Regular City Commissioner Meeting Minutes January 13, 2022 6:30 pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Billy R. Shelton, Mayor Shelton led the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk; all was present, Mayor Shelton established there was a quorum.

Carla Sandusky with Charter Communication presented the board with a Franchise Agreement to provided Broadband Internet throughout the county and the service will need to go through Crab Orchard. After some discussion Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to accept the Franchise Contract with Charter Communication pending the review from our attorney and not conflict of interest with the current cable company, Access Cable, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kenneth Manuel vote 3 yeas, Commissioners Bill Dyehouse, Kenneth Manuel and Rick Spoonamore, one nae, Commissioner Jerry Shelton, motion carried.

Representatives from Lancaster Rural Health Clinic are wanting the Commission to propose a zone change on residence on Lancaster Street from Residential to Commercial in order to open a DR's office. Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to change the zoning to commercial pending the public hearing, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kenneth Manuel all in favor, motion carried.

December 2, 2021 meetings minutes were reviewed no changes were needed, Commissioner Jerry Shelton made the motion to accept the minutes as stand, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Rick Spoonamore all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), no changes need to be made, and Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to accept as stand, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Kenneth Manuel, all in favor, motion carried.

**Commissioner Reports:** 

Emergency Service Commissioner Kenneth Manuel reported Chiefs, Jimmy Gipson's monthly activity report (see attached). City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse wanted to know if there was any update on the lot the city owns behind the clinic. Ann Giles with ALAAC, LLC the clinic owners is no longer a partner and has not responded to any emails regarding the lot. Also there are 14 houses in town that need to be demolished
