Meeting Minutes

Regular Commissioner Meeting, Crab Orchard City Hall December 5, 2024 6:30 pm

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Jesse Harris, Mayor Harris led the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk, all were present, Mayor Harris established there was a quorum.

November 7, 2024 meetings minutes were reviewed. No changes were made, Commissioner Keith Saylor made the motion to accept the minutes as presented, 2nd by Commissioner Mike Eldridge all in favor motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), No changes needed to be made, Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to accept the financials, 2nd by Commissioner Mike Eldridge, all in favor motion carried.

CITY OF CRAB ORCHARD KENTUCKY ORDINANCE No. 25-12-05

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRAB ORCHARD, KENTUCKY ANNEXING 15.12, 104.87 AND 16.18 ACRES CONTIGUOUS WITH EXISITING BOUNDARY OF THE CITY BY SUMMARY

Comes John Hackley, an attorney licensed to practice in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and hereby summarizes Ordinance No.25-12-05 for the purposes of both reading and publication of the Ordinance of Annexation, pursuant to KRS 83A.060(4) and (9).

The Ordinance sets forth the character of the land being annexed, three lots of 15.12, 104.87 and 16.18 acres, respectively, currently portions of US Highway 150, Ky. Hwy. 643, Ky Highway 1770, Ky Highway 39, Ky Highway 3246 and a portion of two County Roads, Harmon Lick Road and William Whitley Road, and references the relevant statutes allowing an annexation by consent, and also the specific consent of the owners of the land to be annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CRAB ORCHARD THAT THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTIES BE ANNEXED INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF CRAB ORCHARD, KENTUCKY

TRACT 1 - 15.12 Acres

The full text of the Ordinance describes by metes and bounds a certain piece, parcel or tract of land located west of, and adjacent to, the existing city limits of Crab Orchard, Kentucky, encompassing portions of KY Hwy. 1770, and William Whitley Road, totaling 15.12 acres, with said description having 56 calls, in Lincoln County.

TRACT 2 - 104.87 Acres

The full text of the Ordinance describes by metes and bounds a certain piece, parcel or tract of land located northwest of, and adjacent to, the existing city limits of Crab Orchard, Kentucky,

encompassing portions of US Hwy. 150, totaling 104.87 acres, with said description having 98 calls, in Lincoln County.

TRACT 3 - 16.18 Acres

The full text of the Ordinance describes by metes and bounds a certain piece, parcel or tract of land located north of, and adjacent to, the existing city limits of Crab Orchard, Kentucky, encompassing portions of KY Hwy. 39, Ky. Hwy. 3246, and County Road, Harmons Lick, and totaling 16.18 acres, with said description having 61 calls in Lincoln County.

The Ordinance notes that the City of Crab Orchard has a zoning ordinance, but the land being annexed, herein, is all road or highway, not necessitating zoning definition, at the time of annexation. Should adjacent public and/or private properties seek annexation as being adjacent to the above described Tracts, each portion of such public or private land then annexed shall be assigned an appropriate zoning designation, from the Lincoln County Zoning Board, and the Crab Orchard City Commission.
