Role call was performed by City Clerk, all were present, except Commissioner Bill Dyehouse and Commissioner Jerry Shelton were absent, Mayor Jesse Harris established there was a quorum.

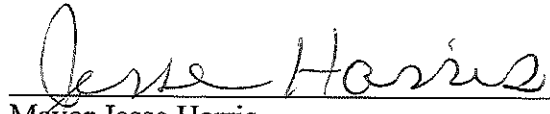

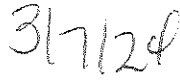
