The meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Jesse Harris, Commissioner Bill Dyehouse led the invocation and Mayor Jesse Harris led the pledge of allegiance to the US flag.

Role call was performed by City Clerk, all were present, Mayor Harris established there was a quorum.

Feb 1, 2024 meetings minutes were reviewed no changes were needed, Commissioner Mike Eldridge made the motion to accept the minutes as presented, 2nd by Commissioner Kenneth Manuel all in favor, motion carried.

Financial report was given by City Clerk (see attached), No changes needed to be made, Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to accept the financials, 2nd by Commissioner Mike Eldridge, all in favor motion carried.

Commissioner Reports

City Commissioner Bill Dyehouse starting to see warm weather and mowing season is here.

Water/Wastewater Commissioner Mike Eldridge reported the WL is 33%. Service Specialties replaced the heat sensor and the UV system is working properly. Tim Blanton for KRWA came down for a few days to look into the sewer system using the cameras to try to pinpoint extra I and I coming into the manholes. The review 4000 feet of sewer on the east end of town, Elm. Manor, Walnut, he found several places of inflow into the sewer. The hydrant at the Post Office has been repaired, it had a bad seal.

Streets and Road Commissioner, Jerry Shelton, stated he spoke with the County Road Dept and they stated the next time they were over here, they will fill the hole in front of the post office where the leak was repaired. Distributed 340K dollars for the County Ambulance Service.

Emergency Services Commissioner, Kenneth Manuel gave Police Chiefs report (see attached) 5 complaints, 4 investigations, 3 drug related investigation, 2 theft investigations, 3 domestics, 10 traffic stops and 5 violation letters sent.

Old Business

- Discussion regarding the variance change for the building next door and Commissioner Kenneth Manuel made the motion to file a grievance over the change of the variance without the city's acknowledgement, 2nd by Commissioner Jerry Shelton vote, 4 yeas, Jerry Shelton, Kenneth Manuel, Mike Eldridge and Bill Dyehouse, Mayor Harris abstained from the vote.
- Update on Annexation, still waiting to get a quote from the surveyor where the area was reduced.

March 7, 2024,

- ABC update, the city will need to have a separate checking account to be set up, Commissioner Jerry Shelton made the motion to set up account at Casey County Bank, 2nd by Mike Eldridge, all in favor motion carried.

New Business

Commissioner Bill Dyehouse made the motion to purchase the Ampstun Utility Software, 2nd by Kenneth Manuel all in favor motion carried.

Water Tower needs to have the outside repairs made and painted, if there are any leftover funds from the KIA stormwater grant.

Easter egg hunt will be Scheduled April 6th at 2:00 pm.

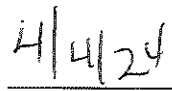
Police Chief Jimmy Gipson has several nuisance letters to be mailed out.

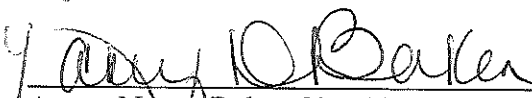

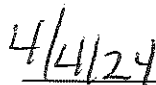
