OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX ORDINANCE CITY OF CRAB ORCHARD ORDINANCE # 01-02-1

The City Commission of the City of Crab Orchard, Kentucky does hereby ORDAIN as follows:

That there is hereby levied a license, privilege and occupational tax on each person, firm, or corporation engaged in business within the city limits of Crab Orchard, Kentucky classified and in the amount of \$35 per year or fraction there of.

That annual license fees or taxes to be paid to the City of Crab Orchard, Kentucky, for the purpose of general revenue hereinafter specified, be and they are hereby imposed upon and required of all persons, firms, and corporations who shall exercise the privileges or engage in the businesses, trades, occupations, and professions hereinafter designated, in said city, for and during each license year hereafter from July 1st to June 30th each, and each succeeding year thereafter, which are as follows to wit:

The issuance and acceptance of each and all of the Licenses hereinabove provided for, and the use and enjoyment of the privileges thereby granted, shall be subject to the following provisions and conditions, to-wit:

The words "person, firms or corporations" used in this ordinance apply to individuals 1. engaged and associated in the same occupation, profession and conducting their business in the same manner as if one person was the sole owner and manager.

- 2. Before exercising any of the privileges of engaging in any business, trade, occupation or profession in the City of Crab Orchard, Kentucky, during said license year, every person, firm or corporation, desiring to do so shall first procure the City License and pay the fee or tax thereon, as hereinabove provided.
- 3. No License shall be transferred or transferable
- 4. All Licenses must be permanently and conspicuously displayed in the original place of business for which they are granted.
- 5. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police and/or Policemen to inspect and report to the Board of Commissioners on proper licenses issued and the proper display of same, and to swear out and have warrant issued for the arrest of violators of this ordinance.
- 6. No partial payment for any kind of license shall be allowed or accepted.
- 7. No license shall be issued for less than a full year, and in no event will license be issued and tax paid for a pro rate portion of the license year.
- 8. Any person, firm or corporation that sells more than one line in the same business shall pay full license fee on the main line and thirty-five (35%) percent on each additional line as set out in the above ordinance.
- 9. After passage and approval of this ordinance, any person, firm or corporation engaging in any business, profession or calling or doing of anything for which a license is required, without first procuring a license therefore, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 or imprisoned in the county jail not less one nor more than thirty days, or both so fined and imprisoned, for each violation, and each day such business, occupation, profession, trade, or calling is engaged in, or the doing of anything for which a license is required, without such license, shall constitute a separate offense, but no prosecution shall be a bar to a civil action for the recovery of the required license fee or fees.
- For non-payment of the license within thirty days after penalty date, the Board of Commissioners may at its desecration instruct the Mayor to order such places of business to close.
- 11. All license fees or tax shall become due and payable on July 1st of each year beginning July 1st, 2001, and if not paid within one month thereafter said fees or tax shall bear interest from July 1st of each year at twelve (12%) percent per month and a penalty of ten percent on the principal sum is hereby levied by reason of non-payment.
- 12. If any section, paragraph, or part of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional excessive or otherwise illegal or void, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall continue and remain in full force and effect notwithstanding such decision or ruling.
- 13. For the purpose of this ordinance each business shall have one proprietor and any additional proprietor shall be considered a full time employee.

- 14. For the purpose of this ordinance full time employee shall be any person working over 30 hours per week; any person working 0-30 hours per week shall be considered part-time and will be counted as ½.
- 15. This ordinance supercedes all prior ordinances governing license fees and taxes except to insurance companies, which are not affected, by this ordinance, and the revenue provided by the ordinance shall be a part of the general fund of the City.
